
### Medzinárodná výstava malieb nevidiacich detí, Atény 2012

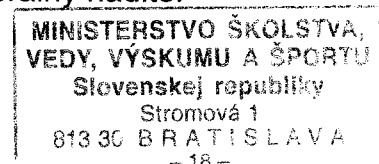



Your Excellency,

The International Exhibition Centre of Children's Paintings in Greece (Study-Research) was founded in 1977. It is a non-profit, non-governmental Association which aims at the dissemination of the message of Peace through the organization of international children's painting exhibitions both for blind children and for children with normal vision. During all these years, the Municipality of Athens, the Ministries of Culture, of Health, of Education, as well as the Foreign Embassies in Athens have supported this effort.

In 2012 we plan to organize the **8<sup>th</sup> International** Exhibition of Blind Children's Paintings aiming to spread the message of Peace through the art across the world. The Exhibition will take place in Athens, at the National Hellenic Research Foundation and it will be under the auspices of the Ministry of Culture (upon our request).

It would be a great honour and pleasure for us if your country, through your Embassy, took part to the aforementioned Exhibition by communicating our document to the relevant schools for blind children of your country. In this way, your Embassy will contribute to our effort for the social and artistic development of blind children by giving them equal chances with those given to children with normal vision.

**ENTRY CONDITIONS:**

- a) Subject: Free
- b) Age of children: 8 -15 years of age
- c) Components: The children works of paintings should be drawn on plain painting paper by choice of the painting material: either felt-tipped pens or watercolors or finger paints or temperas.
- d) Painting's Dimensions: 45 cm width – 35 cm height (these dimensions should be strictly kept) framed by white paper as a background (2 cm from each side). On the painting's front page, on the down right corner, there should be a small label mentioning the first and last name of the child, the age, the sex and the country written in English block capitals. Moreover there should be mentioned whether the child is blind or partially sighted. On the back page of the painting there should be mentioned, in English block capitals, the same to the above data together with the name and address of the school, the telephone number of the school and the name of the teacher.

- e) Number of paintings: Each school should send 5-10 paintings from which three of them will be awarded by the artistic Committee of our Association.
- f) Text by the teacher (optional): The teacher may send a small text by briefly describing the whole process of the children's participation in the Exhibition (method, children's attitude etc)

#### AWARDS CEREMONY AND PRIZES

The prizes, consisting of a parchment and a medal, will be awarded in a special celebrating Ceremony. All prizes will be of equal complimentary value and will be sent to the children through their country's Embassy in Athens.

#### NOTES:

1. Participation is free of charge
2. Deadline for the entry of the painting works: End of November 2011
3. The works of paintings should be delivered to the Founder and President of the International Exhibition Centre of Children's Paintings in Greece, Mrs. Anna Laoutari Gritzala, responsible for the whole organization, in the following address:


